**THE TELECOMMUNICATION ACT**

**THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS (SPECTRUM REGULATORY FEES)  
REGULATIONS, 2003**

In exercise of the power conferred on the Minister by section 26 of the Telecommunications Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telecommunications (Spectrum Regulatory Fees) Regulations, 2003.
2. Each holder of a Spectrum licence falling within the groups specified in the first column of the Schedule shall pay the appropriate regulatory fees to the Authority as specified in the second column of the Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

(Regulation 2)

*Spectrum Regulatory Fees**Licensees**Fees*

## Group I

Licensees who derive no significant commercial benefit from the use of the Spectrum

35% of Spectrum licence fee

## Group II (Level I)

Licensees whose business activities are wholly dependent upon the use of the Spectrum:

$\frac{d}{c} \times e$  which is as follows—

$c$  = aggregate derived annual value of spectrum licence fees paid by all Level 1 users.

$d$  = derived annual value of spectrum licence fee paid by each Level 1 user.

$e$  = \$44M.

## Group II (Level II)

Licensees who use the Spectrum as a preferred means of communication:

70% of Spectrum licence fee.
